

Your sewer bill covers 6 months of service and is not due until the end of those 6 months. We save you money by only billing twice a year. You are welcome to break it down and pay a smaller monthly amount to better fit your budget.

3 ways to pay your sewer bill in monthly increments:

Create a recurring monthly **bank bill pay**, you can use your bank's online bill pay platform or mobile app (This is a free option):

- a. Log in to your online bank account or open the mobile app
 - b. Locate the bill payment tool or select Pay bills
 - c. Add a new payee or select Pay a bill. South Davis Sewer District PO Box 140111 Salt Lake City Utah 84114-0111 801-295-3469 and your _ _ _ _ _ -00 Account number.
 - d. Choose the payment amount and date
 - e. Select a one-time or recurring payment. You can choose recurring and divide your bill into 6 payments.
 - f. Choose the bank account to pay from
 - g. Review and pay
 - h. Remember to cancel this Bank Bill Pay if you sell your home, the account number is linked to the address.
1. Create a recurring **credit card** payment each month: (Note there is a fee to use this option.)
- a. Go to sdsd.us, payment options, and select CREDIT/DEBIT CARD PAYMENTS
 - b. Sign in or create an account by adding your 6-digit Web ID and the first 3 characters of the last name on the account.
 - c. If you have already added your credit card, select "AutoPay". If not, set up a payment method and enter your credit card information. Make sure to check the box for consent. Then return to the dashboard and select "AutoPay".
 - d. Add Autopay. Select the day of the month you want your card to be charged, what month to start, and the amount you want charged each month.
 - e. Save AutoPay Plan.
2. Divide your sewer bill by 6 and mail a **check** each month to South Davis Sewer District. PO Box 140111 Salt Lake City Utah 84114-0111. Make sure to write your sewer account number on the memo line of your check. Save postage and drop your payment off at either Dick's Market at the Customer Service Center.
